- 6. Assess the importance of containment in the period of growing nationalism during the development of the Cold War (1953-68)
- 7. Assess the roles of individuals in the promotion of either democracy or communism during the development of the Cold War (1953-68)
- 8. Assess the effectiveness of détente in the period from 1968 to 1979?
- 9. Account for the emergence of détente in the period from the early 1960s.

- 11. Discuss the significance of the Middle East in the Cold War conflict in the period of détente from 1967 to 1979.

- 13. Account for the collapse of communism in Eastern Europe and the USSR from 1989 to 1991.
- 14. Assess the significance of the policies of Mikhail Gorbachev in ending the Cold War.
- 15. Account for the ending of the Cold War from 1985 to 1991.
- 16. Assess the significance of the Soviet Invasion of Afghanistan and its impact on the collapse of the communism and the end of the Cold War.
- 17. Assess the significance of President Reagan's contributions in ending the Cold War.
